APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

3.1 Education Committee Meeting – November 14, 2023

Ms. Damon moved to approve the minutes from November 14, 2023 and Mr. Tideman seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.

REPORTS:

4.1 Follow-Up Annual Student Academic Assessment Report

Dr. Stange led a follow-up discussion regarding questions asked by District 29 Board of Education members related to the Annual Report on Student Assessment presented at the November 2023 Education Committee meeting. He shared quantitative academic assessment data organized by graduating class, which was requested by the Board. He also shared quantitative academic assessment data by grade level on a “student” versus a “school” normative comparison, which was also requested by the Board. Dr. Stange then introduced Mr. Phillip Earvolino, an independent NWEA MAP data analyst utilized by District 29. Mr. Earvolino shared that, in his experience in analyzing the NWEA MAP data for multiple public schools, the data for District 29 reflects performance at the highest level that is commensurate with or above the highest achieving districts he works with.

4.2 Student Academic Assessment Report- Now What

Ms. Christina Crabtree led a presentation and discussion regarding the application of the annual academic assessment data. She discussed expected outcomes relative to Professional Development, Curriculum Implementation, and Student Performance in the areas of Mathematics, Social-Emotional Learning, Literacy in the Content Areas, Data Literacy and Multi-Tiered Systems of Support.

Mr. Tideman motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:58 p.m. and Ms. Damon seconded the motion. The motion was approved by unanimous vote.
